Whereas, the A&N Administration vide Notification No.316 of 2015 dated 3rd December, 2015 notified "The Andaman and Nicobar Islands Stamp (Payment of Duty by means of e-Stamping) Rules, 2015" for payment of e-stamp duty by means of electronically generated impression on paper through the approved intermediaries/authorized collection centres appointed by the Central Record Keeping Agency with an aim to regulate and streamline the issue of non-judicial stamp papers.

And whereas, it has been reported that people in mass are approaching the authorised collection centres established i.e. Canara Bank, Port Blair and at the respective sub-registries on daily basis for getting stamps/e-stamps of lower denominations for the purposes other than registration. Therefore, in order to avoid over-crowding and to make the process more user friendly, it is proposed to issue e-stamps online for lower denominations upto Rs.1000/-.

Now, therefore, under Rule 45 of the said Rules, the undersigned being Secretary(Revenue), A&N Administration hereby issues the following guidelines for: -

(a) Implementation of online e-stamp certificates by the Central Record Keeping Agency i.e., Stock Holding

(i) Any person paying stamp duty shall visit the website of M/s SHCIL, the Central Record Keeping Agency at https://www.shcilestamp.com and enter online e-stamping payment system.

- (ii) The user can self-register by using personalized login credentials or login to the website as a one-time user for payment of stamp duty. On logging into the website, the user shall select online Stamp Duty option and choose the State/UT concerned. After providing other required details including document's description shall choose online payment method and make payment. The e-stamp receipt shall be printed on A4 sheet paper.
- (iii) The above procedure shall be applicable for payment of e-stamp duty upto an amount of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only) and for e-stamp of value above Rs.1000/-, the same shall be issued at the counters of the approved intermediaries/authorized collection centres as per the procedure stipulated in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Stamp (Payment of duty by means of e-stamping) Rules, 2015.

(b) <u>Digital e-stamping for Digital Document Execution (DDE)</u> by banks and Non-Banking Financial Companies (NBFCs).

- (i) The electronic contract between the customer and the Bank or Non Banking Financial Companies (NBFCs) is pre-filled by the Digital Document Execution (DDE) of National e-Governance Services Limited (NeSL) from the data entered by the lending Bank/NBFC.
- (ii) Digital e-stamping i.e., online and real-time generation of stamp duty certificate inscribed with a unique stamp duty number is generated from SHCIL.
- (iii) The electronic contract along with digital stamp duty certificate is e-signed and the document is shared with NeSL Information Utility and with Bank/Non Banking Financial Companies (NBFCs).
