

Publication of Statistical Information

The Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India (Information Utilities) Regulations, 2017 (IU Regulations) provides that the Information Utility (IU) shall publish statistics related to debt related information in its possession at quarterly intervals. NeSL has now published this information on its website www.nesl.co.in and is available under the tab *Information Utility => Analytical Reports*. Henceforth, these will be published at the end of every quarter.

2. The details available in these four reports are as under:

Report 1	Debt Size Report
Description	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Shows the debt size for all categories of users (Company, Individual and Other Commercial entities) as reported in Form C- Segregated into Fund based and Non-Fund based with submitter count, count of debt records and outstanding amount.
Report 2	Lending Arrangement Analysis Report
Description	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Shows the breakup of loans by type of lending arrangements viz Multiple Banking Arrangement, Sole banking, Consortium, and others- Segregated into Fund based and Non-Fund based with submitter count, count of debt records and outstanding amount.
Report 3	Debt Type Analysis Report
Description	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- The debt type analysis report presents information of the type of debt across four categories: (1) nature of debt, (2) category of debtor, (3) funded/non-funded debt facilities, and (4) secured or otherwise.
Report 4	Default Analysis Report
Description	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Shows the details of default reported to NeSL across various categories of users by both Financial and Operational Creditors.

3. All Financial Creditors are requested to exercise due care during submission of information to the IU so that definitive conclusions can be arrived from the statistical information published by the IU.
