

Pin Code details for E-Stamping mandatory for Madhya Pradesh and West Bengal states

We invite the attention of NeSL DDE users (registered banks and NBFC's), to take note of the below.

We are currently live with E-Stamping for the state of Madhya Pradesh and West Bengal. Please note that for both these states, it is mandatory for the user to pass the *pin code* details of both the parties involved in E-Stamping.

Under the *estampdtls* section of the DDE API request, the below two highlighted fields should be furnished mandatorily if the state of eStamping is Madhya Pradesh or West Bengal.
