Migration of MP IGR e-stamping portal from Sampada 1.0 to Sampada 2.0

We invite the attention of NeSL DDE users (registered Banks and NBFCs) to the following important information. The Inspector General of Registration and Superintendent of Stamps, Commercial Taxes Department, Government of Madhya Pradesh, has transitioned from the current Sampada 1.0 portal to the new Sampada 2.0 portal, effective from April 1, 2025. The integration of Sampada 2.0 with NeSL is currently in progress.

Please note that no fresh fund transfers will occur in Sampada 1.0 with effect from 1st April 2025. Banks are advised to exhaust their existing balances in Sampada 1.0 at the earliest. The current balance can be checked via the Digital Ledger.

NeSL is in discussions with the Government of Madhya Pradesh regarding (a) the possibility of transferring the available balances in Sampada 1.0 to Sampada 2.0 as on the date of completion of integration process, and (b) the option for a refund of any remaining balance. However, it is strongly advised that all banks and NBFCs utilize their existing balance as soon as possible. No fresh fund transfer transactions can take place in Madhya Pradesh till the integration with Sampada 2.0 is complete, however, banks and NBFCs can continue to use Sampada 1.0 portal till their balances are exhausted.
