Details of the new article with digital code, description and stamp duty is as follows: -

Digital Code	Article Number	Article description	Stamp Duty
11	6h*	Agreement if otherwise not provided for-With value	Rupee one for every ten thousand rupees or part thereof of the value, subject to a minimum of one thousand rupees.

^{*} Article 6(h) with present legal instrument shall not be used for any "Loans, neither Secured nor Unsecured"

Kindly incorporate necessary changes in your submission process of DDE, Madhya Pradesh Transactions.

NeSL DDE users are advised to select the right article code/stamp duty amount apt for the contract type. The responsibility for payment of stamp duty lies with the Bank executing the document and therefore NeSL is not responsible for any deficiency in payment of stamp duty. If any, that might arise.
